Conference Venue

The conference will be held on The Open University Campus at Walton Hall, Milton Keynes. The Open University (OU) is known as a world leader in the provision of distance and blended learning. Walton Hall is the central location of the OU and, in keeping with the rest of Milton Keynes, has a park-like feel.

Milton Keynes is easily reached by train and is relatively convenient for most London airports. The campus is 23 miles (37km) from London Luton airport and 54 miles (84km) from London (Heathrow) airport. The OU is a bus or taxi ride from Milton Keynes Central Rail station.
